Pebble Beach Concours D'Elegance 2007

This year's annual event, the 57th, focused on some of the rarest and finest vintage racecars in existence, honoring the '53 Siata racecar by master restorer Ross Stemple with a trophy in the post-war sports & racing class.

As personal apprentice to Bart Williamson and the inspiration for the FrameOff Foundation's apprenticeship program, we are incredibly proud of Ross' accomplishment in having both of his first two Pebble Beach restorations

win trophies. The Siata was given the honor of being lead car in the Tour D' Elegance with proud owner Bob Owens, of Haverford, PA, behind the wheel.



The very first of only thirty-two ever built, this Siata was part of racing history during the 1950's, competing in Santa Barbara and Pebble Beach races.

With these beautiful restorations, last year's elegant 1938 Delahaye and this year's 1953 Siata, Ross has set a wonderful example of achievement to inspire future auto restorers.

Both of these fine classics were restored for Bob Owens by Ross and the team at Mike Wilson Restorations of Visalia, California.
